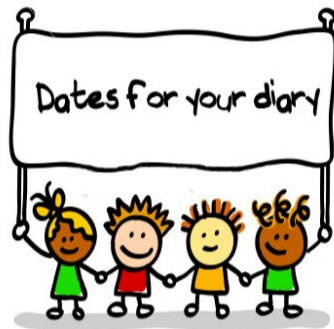

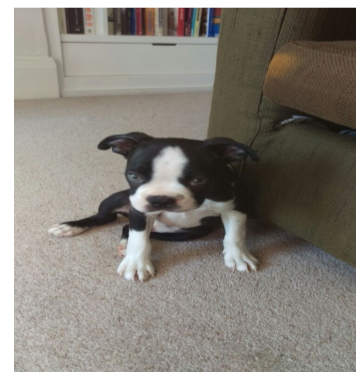

Punctuality

Please ensure that your child is at school on time, every day, so they don't miss any valuable learning. Children in Reception, Year 1 and Year 2 can be dropped off at their classroom from 8:45am, and must be in class by 9am. Children in years 3 - 6 must be in the playground, ready to be collected by their teacher, by 8:55am. This is a good time to have a brief chat with the teacher, if you need to convey a quick message. Longer discussions will need to be at the end of the school day (3:30pm in Key Stage 2 and 3:15pm for years R,1 and 2) or by appointment. Parents/Carers should not be entering the key stage 2 building to speak to the teacher, unless they have an appointment.
