##### School Governors update February 2017

Dear Parents & Carers

This is the first of what we intend to be at least termly updates from governors about what we do. As a new Governing Body for the federated schools we changed our structure and spread our work across 3 committees; (1) Resources, (2) Teaching & Learning and (3) Children, Families and Community. We knew from September that both Schools were due an Ofsted Inspection, so we have done our best to make sure we were ready. We are pleased that both inspections have now been done! Much of our work is guided by the School Improvement Plan which sets out what the School wants to achieve this year and how it is going to get there, in terms of, for example, academic progress and attainment and culture and enrichment. We monitor this by looking at data, as well as the impact of particular initiatives and interventions. Governors have to scrutinise budgets and approve large amounts of spending, whilst making sure that the school is in good financial health. There are new SmartBoards in the Infant School classrooms and improvements planned for the Junior School Gym. We are putting aside money for maintenance of the windows in both schools which will be expensive, but necessary. We often have a small working party of governors on a particular project. At the moment we have a group who, together with the Local Authority, are looking at the Nursery building with a view to making better use of this space.

We want to improve communication this year and hope these newsletter updates will be part of that. We're delighted with the new School website, and you can find governor's details (photo coming soon!) and minutes of meetings here.

Parents/carers are always welcome to observe meetings – please contact the school office to let them know you would like to come. All governors will be in school all day on 9<sup>th</sup> March for "Governors in School Day" to observe activities, meet with various staff and talk to children – it's one of the highlights of our year!
