Addressing Concerns

If you have an issue that you are concerned about then, in the first instance, you should approach your child's class teacher. They are best equipped to discuss most concerns as they work with your children each day. Members of the leadership team, including the Head, will not meet with you until you have attempted to address the concern with the class teacher. Should you feel that a concern has not been addressed sufficiently, you can request a meeting with a member of the leadership team. You can book an appointment via the office. The leadership team will check that you have attempted to resolve the concern with your child's class teacher first.

There have been a number of incidents where parents have taken it upon themselves to speak to children, who are not their own, regarding behaviour towards their own child. It is not acceptable for a parent to challenge other children whatever the reason may be. If you are concerned about a behaviour incident involving your child, make the appropriate appointment to see the class teacher, who will be more than happy to deal with the concern.

Christmas Cards

We now have our Christmas decorations up in both school halls and they look lovely. If children want to give Christmas cards to friends and staff they need to make sure they write the name and class of the person they are sending the card to on the envelope. They should then post the cards into the special Christmas post boxes that can be found in both halls.
