### Governors

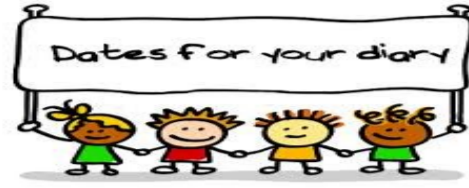
