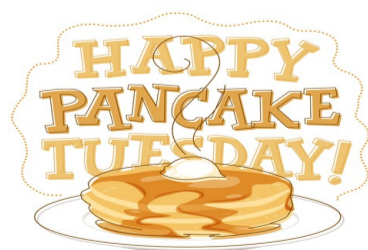


New Baby
