Easter Eggs and Bonnets

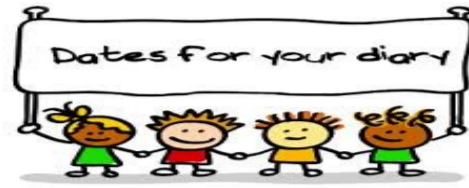
