Great Results

The results from last year's SATs are really pleasing for the school overall. They have given us some improvement priorities for key stage 1, as we want some of the KS1 results to improve next year. The KS2 results are very strong and, on some measures, rank the school in the top 5% of schools nationally. As the results still need to be validated by the DfE, they may vary slightly once the official results are published later this school year:

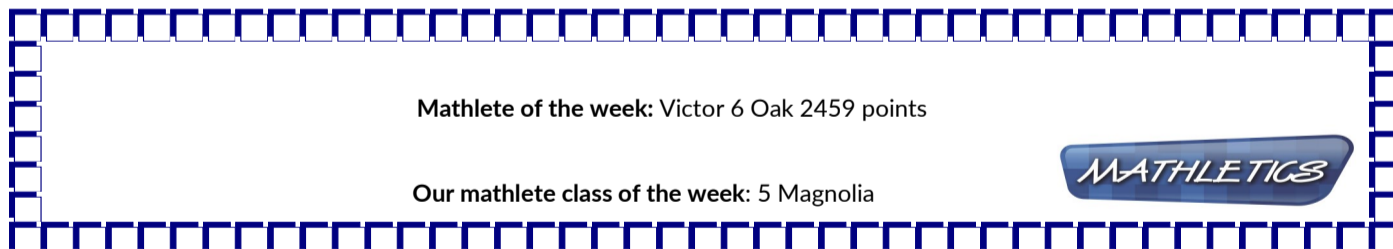

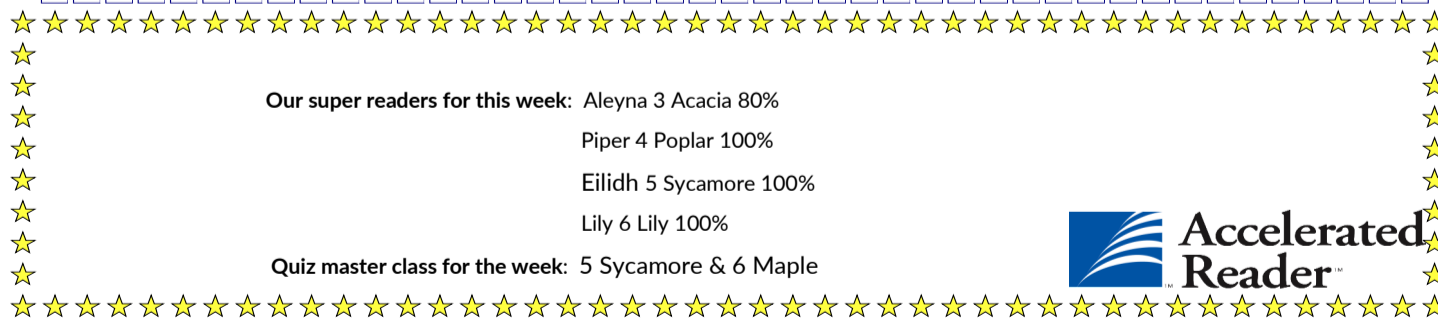
