Sadly we will be saying good bye to some of our lovely TAs and teachers at the end of this school year:

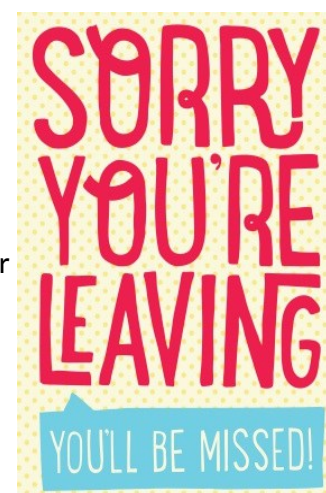
Our TA Zohal is leaving us this month as she has decided to be a dental assistant – good luck Zohal!
