



Year 1 Curriculum News

September 2018

English

This term we will develop our sentence writing skills. We will be learning about finger spaces between words and using capital letters for the names of people, places, the days of the week and the personal pronoun 'I'. Our writing will include fiction and non-fiction. We will be focussing on *Peace At Last*, *The True Story of The Three Little Pigs* and writing a set of instructions. The children will also develop their speaking and listening skills through drama and role play.

We will be practising our handwriting every day.

Maths

In maths, we will be counting to 100 forwards and backwards and reading and writing numerals to 100. We will also be practicing our number bonds to 20 and solving subtraction and addition problems.

The children will also be learning about shapes.

Please practise number bonds to 20 with your child.

Guided Reading

Please make sure your child brings their book bag to school every day. We will be changing guided reading books once a week. Your child will also be bringing a library book home once a week.

Please make sure you read with your child every day.

PE Kit

Your child must bring a PE kit to school. This can be kept in a bag on their peg. Please make sure items are all clearly labelled with your child's name.

Your child must bring a change of clothes for PE, please do not come to school dressed in PE kit at the start of the day.

PE kit should contain a t-shirt, leggings or tracksuit bottoms and a pair of plimsolls or trainers. PE lessons will be outside as much as possible so please also include a sweatshirt.

We will have two P.E sessions a week

Blue Class—Wednesday and Thursday
