



Year 1 Curriculum News

June 2017

English

Our theme this half term is Land Ahoy! We will be reading The Night Pirates, Surprising Sharks and Ice Bear. We will be reading fantasy stories and creating our own fantasy hero.

We will be writing information texts on sea creatures and using our talk for writing actions to learn a traditional poem.

Maths

In Mathematics we will be learning to solve one-step problems involving multiplication and division by calculating the answer using concrete objects, pictorial representations and arrays with the support of the teacher. We will be learning to recognise, find and name a half as one of two equal parts of an object, shape or quantity. We will also be learning to recognise, find and name a quarter as one of four equal parts of an object, shape or quantity.

We will be looking at money and learning to recognise and know the value of different denominations of coins and notes.

12- 15th June 2017 will be a week filled with Art activities. The theme is Best of British and our focus artist will be David Hockney.

RAILWAY FIELDS

We will continue our regular trip to Railway Fields to look at seasonal changes and habitats.

Theme

Our theme this term is "Land Ahoy!"

In Geography, we will Learn about the seas that surround the UK. Develop knowledge of the oceans and continents of the world. Investigate how waves are caused and how they move.

In Science, our topic is 'Holidays'. We will be learning to identify and name a variety of common animals including fish, amphibians, reptiles, birds and mammals. We will also describe the simple physical properties of a variety of everyday materials and their suitability for different climates.

In our Music lessons, we will be learning the ocarina. We will be learning to read music and practising different songs.

In DT (Design Technology) we will be designing, making and evaluating lighthouses.
