## Spring 2018

### English

We will continue to follow the new curriculum, covering newspapers, discussing and analysing the effect of the language choices and the organisation.

The children will be writing their own report, carefully considering the impact on the reader.

We will also study balanced and persuasive arguments whereby the children will be debating topical issues.

### Maths

Continuing to follow the new the curriculum for maths-developing mental and oral strategies; recapping place value, multiplying and dividing decimals by 10, 100 and 1000; using different operations to solve word problems; working on the relationship between decimals, fractions, percentages and ratio.

### PE Kit

Your child must bring a change of clothes for PE, on **Friday** please do not come to school dressed in PE kit at the start of the day.

PE kit should contain a t-shirt, leggings/tracksuit bottoms/shorts and a pair of plimsolls or trainers. As the weather changes PE lessons will be outside as much as possible so please also include a sweat-shirt. This term, the children will be focusing on gymnastics.

### Science

During this term ,the children will be looking at light, thinking about how the eyes see light and how light travels. The children will be able to conduct various experiments to help support their curiosity.
