I am pleased to report that our numbers of children needing to use our provision in school has been low, and has not placed an undue burden on us at this challenging time. Please do not come into school to collect these if you are ill, or self-isolating. Once you have collected your pack please leave the building as quickly as possible, as we should not be socialising with each other at this time.

If you are unable to make it at the time above, we will announce another pick-up time for next week.
