We are still providing a service to some of our vulnerable children, as well as to the children of critical workers who are unable to provide safe supervision of their children at home. Thank you again for supporting us by complying with these measures. As guidance from the government changes, we will adapt our practise and keep you informed.

Unfortunately, our catering company, Pabulum, is unable to sustain a service at our school for the moment, so all children using our provision will need to bring a packed lunch with them from Monday, 30<sup>th</sup> March.
