Dear Parents/Carers,

It really has been a joy having the year 6 children back in school. All of the children have demonstrated exemplary behaviour throughout their return to school. While the situation is far from 'normal,' we are pleased it has allowed all of us to feel we are moving in the right direction.

Our school is planning to get as many children into school as possible, in the last week of the school year (the week beginning Monday, 13th July). This will give children in years R – 5 a chance to spend some time with their current teacher, and some time with their new teacher for September.
