Dear Nursery Parent/Carer,

I hope you and your families are well.

Thank you for participating in our survey over the weekend indicating your preferences for a potential re-opening of our nursery. We are pleased to say that our nursery will opening to all registered children from tomorrow, Wednesday 20th January.

We will have all of the same Covid- safe conditions in place we were using before the current lockdown. However, if you feel you would prefer to keep your child at home for the time being this is absolutely fine. We just ask that you contact us directly, by email (admin@shsharingey.co.uk), and let us know if you are intending to keep your child at home or to send them into school.

The rest of our school will continue to be open to the children of critical workers and/or vulnerable children only. So, if you have older children registered at our school they will not be able to attend unless we have already agreed they meet the criteria.

The nursery will be open for normal hours from tomorrow:

Full time: 8:45am - 3:00pm *
Part time am: 8:45am - 11:45am
Part time pm: 12:45pm - 3:45pm

*Children of critical workers, currently attending nursery, can continue to stay until 4pm.

At this stage we are unable to offer any breakfast club, or after school care.

Thank you for your patience over the last couple of weeks as we have tried to make sense of the conflicting guidance provided by the Government in relation to nurseries and the rest of the school.
