Dear Parent/Carer,

As you have likely heard by now, within hours of my last writing to you, the Government has changed its decision regarding Haringey primary schools reopening next week.

This means that our school will be open only to **vulnerable children**, and the **children of key workers**, from Wednesday, 6th January through to Friday, 15th January. You can find the criteria for both of these categories by [clicking here](#).

We are currently experiencing some staffing limitations, as some members of staff have tested positive, and others are self-isolating. So, we would ask if you have the ability to keep your child/ren at home please do so.

In two parent/carer households we expect that both meet the criteria to gain a place for your child. While we empathise with the difficulty for all workers when children are at home, we need to keep the number of children in school to a minimum.

Our online learning will launch on Wednesday 6th January via Google Classroom. We ask that you attempt to login to your child/ren's Google Classroom account before Wednesday 5th and, as in the past, please contact us via email if you are having any difficulties accessing your child's online learning. You can do so by emailing the school's admin: admin@shsharingey.co.uk

Children coming into school will also be using the online learning content. When possible, children will be in year group bubbles. However, staffing limits may mean we need to create larger bubbles at times.

The bubbles will run from 8:45am – 4pm daily. There will be no breakfast clubs or after school clubs during this period.

To secure a place for child please email (admin@shsharingey.co.uk) ASAP providing the following information:

- Your child's name and class
- The days of the week you would like them to attend

We will need you to provide proof for your employment (for both parents/careers where applicable). You can send this via email, or bring it with you on the first morning of dropping your child off.

If you previously provided evidence during the last round of key worker provision you do not need to send the evidence again.

We will write you confirming your child's place by Tuesday, 5th January.
