Dear Parent/Carer,

We are pleased to say that we will be holding a sports day for the Junior School children next Monday, 21st June. After the disappointment of missing this special day in our school calendar last year, we are all keen to make it a safe and successful day for the children.

We will be walking to and from Finsbury Park for the event. Unfortunately, due to the ongoing Covid 19 restrictions, we are unable to invite you to come and watch. The guidance is clear that audiences for outdoor events cannot exceed 30 individuals. So, to be fair to all, we are keeping this event free of spectators. We know many of you will be disappointed, as are we, but the most important thing is our children will be enjoying a sports day this year.

We do have some parent volunteers assisting us on the day and we thank them for their help in advance. We have enough volunteers already.
