Dear Parents/Carers,

### **KS1 Pupils**

We hope you have had a good summer break and are ready for your child to return to school on **Friday 3<sup>rd</sup> September**.

Over the summer break, we have continued to work on our risk assessment to ensure we minimise risk to each year group, taking account of the new guidance. From Friday 3<sup>rd</sup> September:

- Start times: **Reception 8:50am, Year 2 8:55am, Year 1 9:00am** parents will enter using the **top Pemberton Road gates** and will still be expected to exit via the **lower Pemberton road gate**.
- Finish times: **Reception 3:00pm, Year 2 3:05pm, Year 1 3:10pm** using the **top Pemberton Road gates** and will still be expected to exit via the **lower Pemberton road gate**.
- Children will enter the school building by themselves and parents will not be permitted in the building.
- Each year group will continue to have their own lunch time, this will mean they have separate time and area to eat and play from other year groups.

**Breakfast club** will start on **Friday 3<sup>rd</sup> September** at 8am for children in **Years 1-6** who are already registered. Alongside this, our after-school club, **'The Green'** will be starting on **Friday 3<sup>rd</sup> September** for children in **Years 1-6** who are already registered.

Whilst allowances were made during the last year for some exceptions to school uniform due to pressures caused by the pandemic, all children are now expected to return to school in full school uniform this year. If you feel you would benefit from our donated school uniforms, please let our school office know by emailing or phoning the school office.

If your child develops ANY of the three main symptoms of COVID-19, however mild, they should not come to school, should get a PCR test and inform the school of the result.

The main symptoms have not changed and are as follows:

- **A high temperature**
- **A new continuous cough**
- **A loss of, or change in, normal sense of taste or smell**
