Dear Parents/Carers,

KS1 Pupils

It was wonderful to welcome our children and their families back into our school today. All of the children have settled back into school life and we look forward to a successful year.

As with my previous letter, we have worked hard over the summer break and we continue to work on our risk assessment to ensure we minimise risk to each year group, taking account of the new guidance. We are always open to feedback and listen to feedback from our families and community on any issues that may present themselves. To that end, we have adapted our KS1 school start and finish times to better support our families. Please see below the changes that will take place in KS1, from Monday 6th September:

- Start times: **the gates will be opened at 8:50am for all children in Reception, Year 1 and Year 2.** Parents will still enter using the **top Pemberton Road gates** and will still be expected to exit via the **lower Pemberton road gate**. We expect parents to drop their child off promptly and move on quickly as to not create an area of overcrowding. All children should be in school, ready to learn, by 9am.
- Finish times: **Reception: 3:15pm, Year 1 and Year 2 3:20pm.** Parents will still enter using the **top Pemberton Road gates** and will still be expected to exit via the **lower Pemberton road gate**. We ask that parents move on promptly at the end of the day as to not cause any overcrowding.
- Children will enter the school building by themselves and parents will not be permitted in the building.
