### **Homework**

At South Haringey School, much of what children learn requires regular practise in order to ensure that they become confident and independent in using and apply their skills. The homework is as follows for each phase:

#### **KS1 – Yr1 & 2**

Pupils will be sent home with 3 books: a book of their choice; a phonic book appropriate to their phonic level if they are in a phonics groups; and a guided reading book appropriate to their level.

Pupils will be sent home with a spelling list every Friday and be expected to learn these by the following Friday.

Yr2 will have tasks set on Mathletics on a weekly basis to complete.

#### **KS2– Yr3–6**

Pupils will take home two books from the library matched to their reading ability. Some children who attend additional interventions such as Read, Write, Inc will also bring a book matching their phonic level.

Spelling tasks will be set on a Friday on Spelling frame, an online portal, and pupils will need to learn them ready for the following Friday.

Pupils will have tasks set on Mathletics on a weekly basis.

Please watch out for curriculum newsletters and additional log-in information as we set children up with their homework tasks over the next week.
