The artwork can be made using any medium. It can be a painting, sculpture, photograph, installation, video, drawing, or a combination. There is no theme so the artwork can be of any subject. Children are able to submit one piece of art work each, however, their artwork will need to be submitted by a teacher or parent on behalf of the child.

If your child chooses to enter the competition, they will need to create their entry at home. Their entry will need to be photographed and then submitted to the Royal Academy Young Artists website on, or before **29th March 2023**. The school is registered, so in order to submit an entry you can use this link and provide information on the title, size, medium and description of the piece of work:

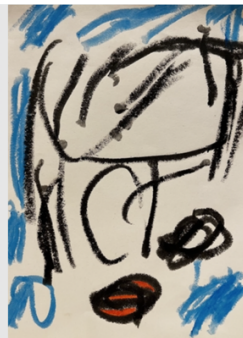

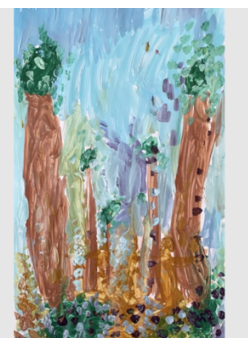
