At the bottom of this page we have a photo of our first entry into the exhibition. On the second page we have included some photos of resources Feryal herself made for you to see and draw inspiration from.

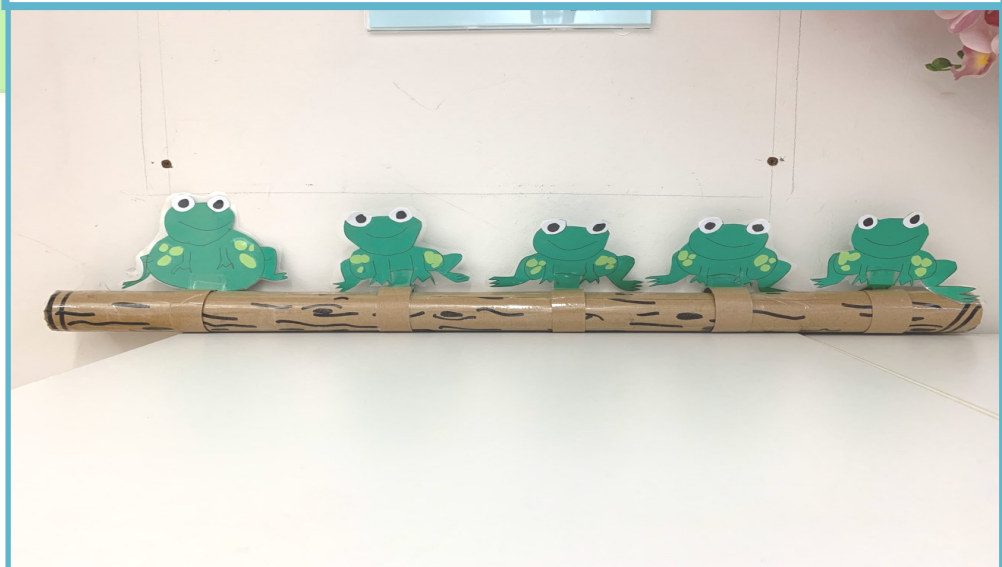
You can start handing in your entries on Monday, 17th April with last entries received by **Friday, 21st April.**
