Introducing the Haringey School Nursing Service and Parent Portal

We would like to re-introduce ourselves as your School Health Service. We work across education and health with the aim of improving the health and wellbeing of children and young people. The Haringey School Nursing Service are now using the School Health Parent Portal, to deliver our Child Health Needs Questionnaire which is sent every year to parents whose children are in Reception and Year 6.

The questionnaire gives you the opportunity to highlight any health concerns you have for your child and whether you require support from the School Nursing Service. To complete this, you will firstly need to register for a parent portal account. The School Health Team ensures that personal information relating to your child is kept securely and confidentially. Information will not be shared without your permission except in exceptional circumstances. Please take a few minutes to read through the information provided in the link below. This will give you a clearer understanding of what we aim to deliver.

What do I need to do?

- 1. Click on the link below, this will take you to the registration landing page
- 2. Register for a school health parent portal account using just an email
- 3. Check your email inbox to create a password. It is important that you keep hold of your Username and password for future logins.
- 4. Log into portal to read further information about health programmes
