

Yr 6 Curriculum News Summer 2024

English

Throughout this term, we will consolidate the writing skills that we have acquired during our time in KS2. We will be writing pieces from a variety of genres and for different purposes. We will focus on the impact that our writing has on the reader.

The teaching of spelling and grammar will be integrated into each lesson.

Whole class and guided reading will take place daily and will cover a range of texts which directly link to our writing topics.

PE

After some work to consolidate what we have learnt in KS2 so far, we will focus on project work in our Maths lessons.

We will solve problems linked to real life scenarios and be given the opportunity to apply our mathematics skills and knowledge in different ways. We will: solve puzzles; test mathematical statements; reason and have fun playing with numbers in equations.

History and Geography

In Geography, in our topic Interconnecting Amazon., we will be learning about agriculture across the world, then zooming into the Amazon basin, a region of South America.

In History, we will be learning Ancient civilisations in central America: the Maya.

In Music, we will be working on composition and performance skill. One of our units of work is called Dancing in the Street.
