Years 4 and 6 visit The British Museum



Last week, both Year 4 and Year 6 visited the British Museum to consolidate their growing historical knowledge. Year 6 began with Anglo-Saxon England, followed by the world in AD 900, focusing on Maya, Islamic and West African culture and society. The children participated in a workshop using a range of resources; they showed that they are able historians, who can make links and connections between different civilisations and can use different sources to make inferences.

The same week, Year 4 went on their second trip of the year to the British Museum! This time, they attended a workshop about Roman Britain, which is their current topic in History. After learning about life in Iron Age Britain before the arrival of the Romans, the children learnt how the Romans changed Britain and were introduced to some of the museum's amazing artefacts from the period. The children had an opportunity to show off their knowledge of the subject by answering questions, before returning to South Harringay feeling tired but thoroughly inspired!


