Dear Parent/Carer,

We would like to invite you to a meeting held by a representative from Haringey's school admissions team on **Thursday**, **3**rd **October from 3:45pm, in 6 Maple**, where you will be given guidance on applying for a secondary school.

As a school we do not handle any of the application process, but we realise that some of you might like a little advice. The responsibility for researching and arranging visits and the actual application rests with you.

The main points we will cover in our meeting are:

- You will need to complete the application yourself and make sure it is submitted before the deadline of 31
 October 2024
- The <u>preferred method is an online application</u>-(<u>www.haringey.gov.uk/admissions</u>)
- Secondary schools hold open events during the autumn term. It's a chance for you to get to know your
 local school. You must check the school's website for details of open events; take note of the open days
 for the schools you are interested in and let us know in advance if you want to take your child along for a
 visit during school time.
- If you live in another Local Authority you will need to use their admission service and should contact them for guidance
- You can put down school schools in other Local Authorities on a Haringey form

If you are unable to attend the meeting, Haringey offer online talks to help parents and carers apply for secondary school places. Each talk lasts about 30 minutes with time afterwards to ask questions.
