Junior Climbing Frame

Many of you will have noticed the climbing frame in the Junior School playground is having some work done on it. We have all equipment checked annually and the most recent check led to one of our boom nets being replaced. The replacement boom net is on the way, but it may still take a few weeks to arrive. In the meantime, we have barriers around the ground, where the boom net is anchored, to avoid the trip hazard; there is a temporary barrier at the top of this section. The rest of the climbing frame is safe to use.



This is also a good time to remind you that, use of the climbing frame and other playground equipment after school, is at the risk of the parent or carer accompanying each child. This is because our staff are not on duty to supervise play. Instead, staff are focused on making sure all children leave school with an appropriate adult. If you choose to let a younger sibling play while you wait for a junior school child, you are responsible for them.
