Authentic but colourful! Plenty of tunics, tights and stripy socks!

Robin-Traditional 'Robin Hood' look: white long sleeve, green tunic, belt and green tights and feathered hat

Will- Traditional 'Robin Hood' look: white long sleeve, red tunic, belt and red tights (plus bow and glasses).

Alan- Traditional 'Robin Hood' look: white long sleeve, green tunic (additional musical accessories), belt and green tights.

Tuck- Traditional monk's long brown cassock, wig and large belly!

Big John and Little John: Traditional 'Robin Hood' look: white long sleeve, green tunic, belt and green tights.

Much- Traditional 'Robin Hood' look: white long sleeve, green tunic, belt and green tights (muscles and lots of hair!)

Dave- Traditional 'Robin Hood' look: white long sleeve, green tunic, belt and green tights (plus '70s dancer' elements e.g leg warmers/sweat bands).

Sherriff of Nottingham- Black tunic, belt and trousers. Long black gloves, possible chain mail and/or black cloak.

Guards (Nigel, Norbet, Nesbit, Norton, Newt)- Black top, black trousers and stripy socks (we will be making tunics at school)

Nursie- Victorian nurse dress. Eccentric 'dame', more outlandish e.g wig/glasses for comedic effect!

Kings- Traditional medieval king costume including crown.

Grabbit and Bolt- bright stripy socks and brightly coloured tunic with G or B on the front.

Gavin- Comical dungeon master, think enthusiastic holiday rep. Brightly coloured blazer, white shorts, polo shirt, stripy socks and plimsols.

Ghengis- "Quasimodo" look: ragged clothes, unruly hair and dirty face.

Billy- Shakespearean playwright

Skunks- "scout" look e.g white top, plain shorts, waistcoat and neckerchief

Villagers- 'medieval look' e.g plain long sleeve top, plain trousers/ plain dress, tunic (cut off the sleeves and neckline of an old t-shirt to make a simple tunic), vest/waistcoat, belt, cloak. Could add spotted/striped socks/headband/neckerchief

Guy and Gladys- Wealthy medieval dress

Marion- Traditional long dress, flower garland
