# **English and Reading**

In English, we have completed our analysis and creation of metaphorical poems based on Joseph Coelho's work. We are currently reading 'The Iron Man' by Ted Hughes where we have engaged in a few creative tasks. After the half term, we will be reading a range of literature including Macbeth and producing playscripts based on the story. Teaching of spelling and grammar will be integrated throughout our daily lessons.

# PE: Year 5 PE is on Thursdays

In PE, we will be covering the following units of work:

- Football and Tag Rugby
- - Netball, Basketball and ball manipulation

Your child must come to school in their PE kit. It should contain a **white t-shirt**, **black tracksuit bottoms/shorts** and a pair of trainers. As the weather changes, PE lessons will be outside as much as possible so please also include **a black sweatshirt**.

In addition to P.E, children will have swimming lessons every Tuesday. Please ensure their kit includes: a swimming costume, or shorts; underwear; a towel; and a swimming hat.

# Homework

Children will choose a library book weekly which should be read at home over the course of a week. They will be asked to take a quiz on these books in class to assess their comprehension. Children also have access to online subscriptions where we encourage them to engage in to consolidate their learning.

Spellings will be set on Fridays on Spelling Frame, which the children should practice in preparation for their test the following Friday. Children will be set weekly Mathletics tasks which they are required to complete. During half term holidays, children will be set a project based around their current learning.

#### **Maths**

In Maths, we have completed a block of work on number and place value as well as the four operations and we are just beginning a new block of work on fractions. Within our lessons, fluency, mental maths and reasoning is integrated throughout our lessons.
