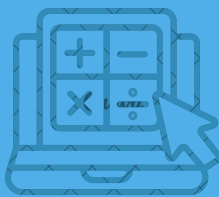
## Online Safety

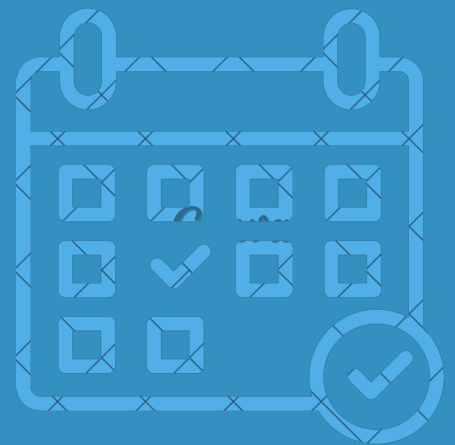
