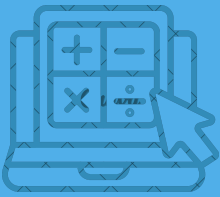

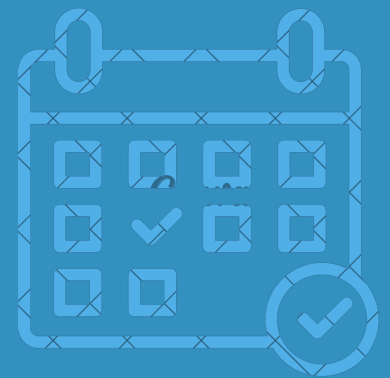

Medication

A reminder that medication can only be administered to a child in school if it has been prescribed and a completed care plan is in place. Please note that we are unable to administer any non-prescribed medication. However, if you wish, you are welcome to come into school and administer it yourself.

Alternatively, you can email the admin team to request a copy of the care plan to complete electronically.

It is also important to notify the school and complete a care plan if your child has had a fracture or injury that may affect their ability to complete school tasks such as writing or PE. Completing a care plan helps us ensure that class teachers are informed and that the appropriate support is put in place.
