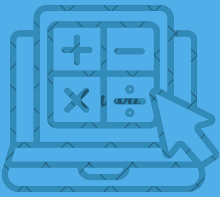
## Peregrine House

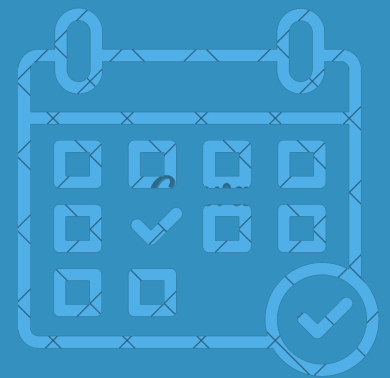
