suitsors.

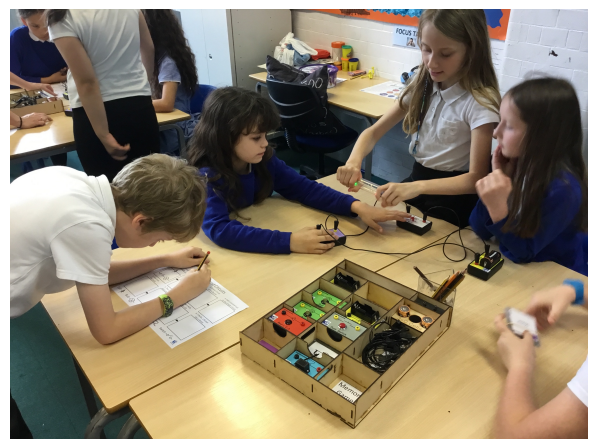
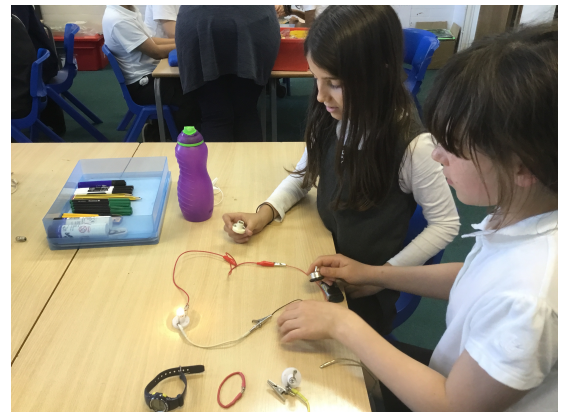
Once all the suitsors had been

goodoption!



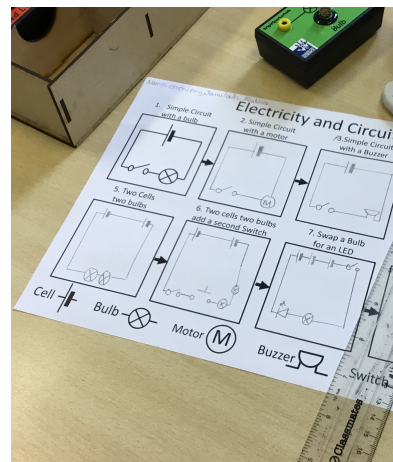
CLOTHING

You can also wear warm socks, waterproof pants and gloves.

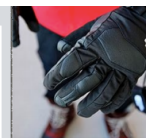
You should take couple of thin, warm base layers than don't itch.
