**Breakfast Club for Nursery, Reception, Year 1 and Year 2**

As you are aware we have previously been unable to offer EYFS/KS1 children, who were not already registered, a place at our breakfast club. As with all of our processes this has been under constant review and we are now happy to inform you that we are able to offer a limited number of breakfast club places to EYFS and KS1 families who were not previously registered. We will be fulfilling places on a first come first served basis. If you are offered a place your child will be able to start breakfast club from **Thursday 15<sup>th</sup> October at 8am**.

We have continued to work on our risk assessment to ensure we minimise risk to each year group 'bubble.' This means that children will only come into regular contact with other children in their year group. Some of the implications of this for breakfast club are:

- Parents will not be allowed into the school building and must leave their child to enter via the annex doors on Mattison road, where they will be received by members of staff in breakfast club.
- Parents and pupils should ensure they maintain appropriate social distancing from other parents and children. Upon arrival, please ring the bell and wait for the door to open.
- Pupils will sit in year group tables and will not be able to mix with other year groups in order to maintain the integrity of the bubbles.
- Each year group will be allocated a variety of board games to play with in their year group bubbles instead of a play session in the gym or outside as previously the case.
