On Thursday night there was a zoom meeting of the Harringay Ladder Healthy Streets Group.

They discussed a proposal to put to the council for how to reduce through traffic in the area. The key aims are to introduce a scheme that would enable every house on the ladder to retain car / delivery access whilst making the ladder and Wightman Roads less attractive as short cuts for people driving through the area, and improving the area for active travel (walking or bikes).
