Some of you have asked why the school was not officially graded as outstanding as a result of the report. As we were already a 'good' school according to Ofsted's criteria, the inspection did not allow for an official judgement of outstanding. However, the report does acknowledge the school has made significant improvement since our last 'good' inspection and there was evidence we could be considered outstanding, if a full inspection was conducted. This means an inspection team will return within the next two years for another inspection. We're looking forward to showing them how fantastic our school is.

We are expecting an inspection of the Junior School soon.

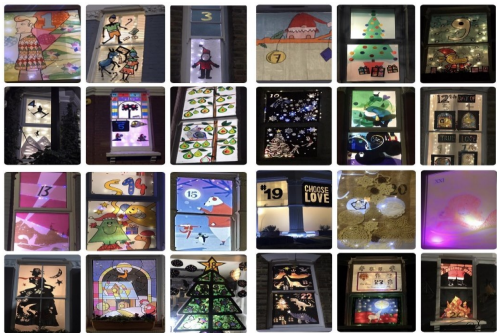
