As many of you will know, we had a two-day, section 8, Ofsted inspection in the Junior School last week. Bikeability

Last week, children in year 5 & 6 took part in Bikeability Level 2 cycle training. The training develops skills for cycling on single-lane roads with simple junctions and moderate traffic and includes the core functions for safe and responsible cycling. The children learnt to: make good and frequent observations; communicate their intentions clearly to others; choose and maintain the most suitable riding position; and understand priorities on the road, particularly at junctions.
