The report from the March Ofsted inspection of the Junior School is now available on our website (click here to read the report). We now have a pair of reports of which we are very proud.


Some of you have asked why the school was not officially graded as outstanding as a result of the report. As we were already a 'good' school, according to Ofsted's criteria, the inspection did not allow for an official judgement of outstanding. However, the report does acknowledge the school has made significant improvement since our last 'good' inspection and there was evidence we could be considered outstanding, if a full inspection was conducted.

So, we will have a return visit from an inspection team, in both schools, within the next two years to confirm the outstanding judgment. We're looking forward to showing them how fantastic our school is!
