Homework

- When reporting your child absence by phone, email or voicemail, please state their symptoms e.g., cough, vomiting, temperature. We will need to contact you if you simply state 'unwell' as the reason for absence.

Roads as School Streets. This means that there will be restricted car access, to both roads, for about a half hour before the start of school and at the end of the school day. We will of course give you more details once we have them, so that those of you that do drive have plenty of notice to make alternative

plans. We don't expect this to start until spring 2023.

In the meantime, please be reminded that the yellow zig-zag lines, which are on the roads outside of both main entrances, are there to ensure that the space outside of school remains clear so that children can be seen more easily when they are crossing the road. Please do not park on these lines when dropping off or picking up your child.
